unanimously accepted by the General Assembly of UEP at their XV Congress, Erlangen (Federal Republic of Germany) September 17, 1988
and

supported by the Committee on Phoniatics and Voice Care of the International Federation of Oto-Rhino-Laryngological Societies (IFOS).

Sent in to WHO, but not incorporated in current ICD 10.

May be used as a reference for further revisions.

315.0 Delay of language development (including dysgrammatism, reading, writing, spelling, and, generally, learning disorders)

315.1 Dyslalia

315.5 Social, cultural, emotional, behavioral disorders

768 Intrauterine hypoxia and birth asphyxia

768.5 Severe birth asphyxia

1-minute Apgar score 0 - 3

pulse less than 100 per minute at birth and falling or steady, respiration absent or gasping, color poor, muscle tone absent, "White asphyxia"

768.6 Mild or moderate birth asphyxia

1-minute Apgar score 4 - 7

normal respiration not established within one minute, but heart rate 100 or above, some muscle tone present, some response to stimulation, "Blue asphyxia"

768.9 Unspecified birth asphyxia in liveborn infant

389 Disturbances of Hearing

389.0 Sensorineural hearing disturbances, bilateral, prelingual

389.1 Sensorineural hearing disturbances, bilateral, postlingual

389.2 Conductive hearing disturbances, bilat., preling.

389.3 Conductive hearing disturbances, bilat., postling.

389.4 Comb. sensorineural-conductive hear. dist., bilat., preling.

389.5 Comb. sensorineural-conductive hear. dist., bilat., postling.

389.6 Unilateral hearing loss or deafness with unrestricted hearing on the contralateral side

Subdivision by further decimals

389.0.0 minimal (up to 25 dB)

389.0.1 slight (26 - 40 dB)

389.0.2 moderate (41 - 60 dB)

389.0.3 severe (61 - 80 dB)

389.0.4 hearing loss close to deafness (above 80 dB)

389.0.5 deafness
